**SUBJECT: MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT: MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE GREATER LOS ANGELES COUNTY VECTOR CONTROL
DISTRICT**

BACKGROUND

The Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District has requested that the City Council appoint or reappoint a representative to serve as Trustee for a two-year term, beginning on January 5, 2025 and expiring in January 2027. This appointment requires approval by the City Council.

DISCUSSION

Councilmember Isabel Aguayo currently serves as the City's representative member of the Board of Trustees of the Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District. She was originally appointed to a two-year term in November 2020 and then reappointed in November 2022. Her current term will expire on January 5, 2025. The Mayor proposes to appoint Councilmember Isabel Aguayo. Upon approval of this appointment, staff will inform the Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District of the appointment.
